In your mercy, Lord . . . **hear our prayers.**

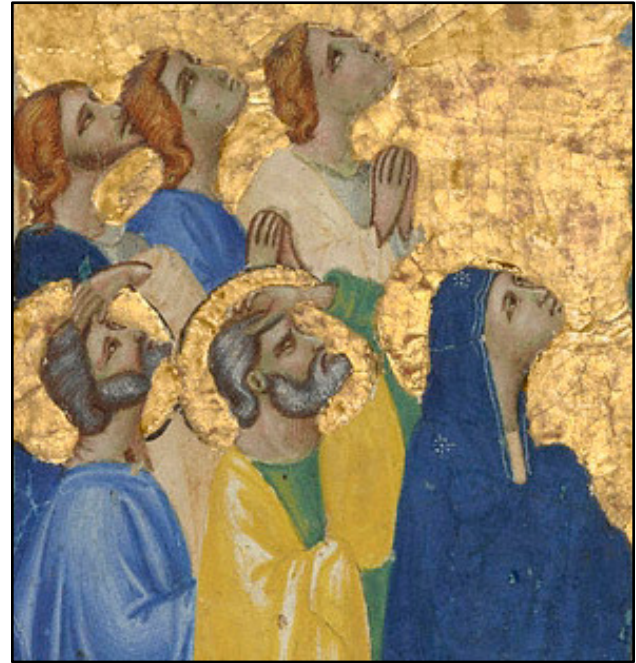
May your kingdom come and may your church be strengthened . . .
